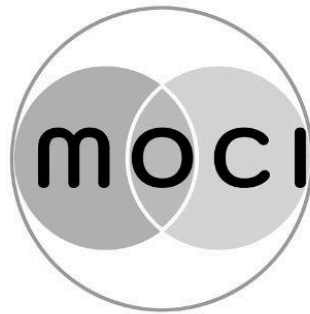

Integral Knowledge

Question:

Knowledge doesn't seem to be an important aspect of what you're writing about. It seems you're more interested in behavior. Why?

Answer:

Knowledge is vital, perhaps the most crucial aspect of my writings. But which knowledge? If we're talking about esoteric, cosmological, or scientific knowledge, then you're right—I don't focus on these as much. What I emphasize is Integral Knowledge.

Knowledge is highly subjective and personal to an individual in spacetime. It can be honed and refined for one person, and if another person encounters this "knowledge," they might call it a belief, possibly even a misguided one. Thus, knowledge is subjective. Even widely accepted theories like Evolution, Special Relativity, the Big Bang, or Quantum Field Theory are subjective, because we interpret and scrutinize them within our local universe.

Knowledge is personal and often wavering, blending with what we call belief. Integral Knowledge is the innate, inner belief that we acknowledge and affirm we are both infinite and interconnected. Integral knowledge revolves around these two interrelated beliefs, and from this hub, spokes jut out into all of our beliefs and all of our knowledge like the lattice of an all-encompassing neural network.

Integral Knowledge defines life as interconnected through a shared, innate belief that all existence is infinite, without exception. Even the materiality of planets—organic and human-made—is infinite. The energy and vibration underlying all materiality are infinite, as the infinite occupies and creates the apparent finite.

The infinite creates the finite. The finite can create the finite, but it cannot create the infinite. Regardless of how it is created, whatever is created remains infinite. Its energetic signature is recorded in the moment of infinite time. It lives as a member of the material dimension, and is accorded its domain within the record of spacetime.

Integral Knowledge is the only knowledge we share without thoughts and words. All other knowledge, whether personal or shared, is always evolving in words, numbers, and images. Its rate of evolution is the input of local spacetime, which fluctuates with technology. As

technology becomes increasingly a reflection of human intelligence it will accelerate the subjective experience of spacetime.

Integral Knowledge isn't found in hallucinogenic trips or sensory experiences. It is a shared knowledge within all things, and therefore it cannot be an experience, for the simple reason that we cannot experience all things. It is a knowledge that we can only acknowledge. We can nod our heads in recognition and acceptance, but we cannot experience it. What we can do is to allow the knowledge to become our hands, feet, mouth, mind, and heart. We allow these parts of us to become animated by this Integral Knowledge.

Integral Knowledge is crucial as it facilitates applying past learnings to the present moment. This has little to do with formal education or human intelligence. Animals with smaller brains, and trees with no brains at all, understand Integral Knowledge instinctively through their DNA. They understand that the physical interface of a body is not infinite. It is a creation tool of the infinite.

The idea is that knowledge isn't singular. There is personal knowledge, Integral Knowledge, and shared knowledge in our interactions. These are the three sources of knowledge inception—in other words, where knowledge comes from.

Where knowledge goes, well, that's up to us. The highest knowledge we can understand in any received moment of time is precisely what each of us in our local universes are all experiencing. Every single life in every moment, is a form of unity, a part of the greater organism, with our planet as its collective base.

Our planet is part of a galaxy in the same way that we are parts of our planet. The galaxy is part of a local group of galaxies that is part of a universe that is part of a multiverse that is part of an infinite multiverse. Within all of that expansion, there's a thread between the local universe of an individual life form, and the One and All who interoperates the infinite multiverse.

Knowledge transmits through our overlaps, rippling out wider than we realize. This transmission is woven throughout spacetime dimensions across the infinite multiverse. It's always been this way and will continue infinitum. We exist to receive and transmit knowledge. To understand our role in service to this knowledge and to each other.

If we feel our personal knowledge is unduly influenced by external overlaps of knowledge, we can modulate this influence. Our greater perspective is tuned to achieve a personal balance, but we are not taught about Integral Knowledge—not in its pure state.
